4. <u>Report from K-12 Executive Director</u>

In June, HCS had representatives from the Hoboken Police Department, the NJDOE Office of School Preparedness and Emergency Planning and the Hudson County Prosecutor's Office come to observe a security drill. Deirdra Grode, Jenna Blackman, SK Duff, Sean Gavarny and Courtney Leahy participated in this drill observation and met with the school safety and security experts after to review ways in which we can continue to make our school safer. The team commended the school and staff on its readiness and preparedness overall and provided many great strategies that we'll incorporate into procedures/protocol this summer and will share with the full K-12 team at orientation.



The end of the school year was busy with Field Day, 8th and 12th grade graduation ceremonies, senior presentations to members of the Board and faculty/staff panelists, an end of the year dance for grades 9-12, a middle school science fair, numerous publishing parties and a variety of field trips. It was a great end to another successful school year for our student and staff.

5. <u>Report from Lower and Middle School Principal</u>

HCS's first band competition was a huge success! Mr. Gavarny brought 76 middle school students to Pennsylvania for this competition where all three ensembles earned an "Excellent" rating and earned trophies for the school. Combined with the beginner band, our HCS band program has 100 students participating. The students celebrated their hard work with an end of year band Party in June.

6th through 8th graders had an opportunity to earn the President's Award for Educational Excellence and attend an end-of-the-year honorary breakfast with Ms. Grode at Stacks Pancake House and Cafe. At this breakfast, students were awarded a certificate with signatures from the U.S. Department of Education Secretary of Education as well as the President of the United States. Students could earn this award by earning a coursework cumulative average of 90% across their classes for the year and by completing a designated number of service hours specific to their grade level. Service work included: serving as teacher assistants in projects after school, serving meals or organizing materials at the local homeless shelter, leading fundraisers and drives for a cause of choice, participating in local clean-up days and participating in walkathons. Students who earned honor roll for third trimester and students with perfect attendance were also recognized at the breakfast.

6. <u>Report from Upper School Principal</u>

On June 16th, our seniors presented their service-based senior projects. These capstone projects were a culmination of the seniors' academic experiences here at HCS and provided the students with an opportunity to merge their various interests, passions, and curiosities with their academic lives while demonstrating autonomy and critical analysis skills.

On June 19th, the Hoboken Charter School held their Upper School's Commencement ceremony.

Congratulations to Mariam Ahmed, Class of 2015, who was awarded this year's Rotary scholarship.

The month of June shows the estimated final balances prior to the audit. These include the final 6/30 enrollment count. The net difference in enrollment counts was (.5) meaning that the net enrollment did not change from 10/15/14. There were changes between enrollment between districts and the total adjustment aid. The major long term change was due to the increase in the upper school enrollment. Expense changes centered on the increased maintenance and facility costs. This FY end was one of the most successful in years, especially since the move to 713 Washington Street.
