Dear Parent/Guardian:

We are thrilled that you are interested in becoming a part of the vibrant Hoboken Charter School learning community. We are currently accepting applications for the 2020-2021 school year, grades K-12.

The Hoboken Charter School was conceived and developed by a group of Hoboken parents and professional educators who shared the goal of designing a K-12 learning community committed to innovation, social change and a different way of learning. The values of social justice and service learning taught through learner-centered practices serve as the foundation for HCS's program and guide decision-making at every level. These values underlying each student's education do not vary as the child progresses but rather deepen and become actualized with experience and age. This makes the transition from lower, middle and upper school more fluid, allowing each step to build more solidly on the preceding one. Our mission, size and dedication to providing an inclusive learning community that spans a child's thirteen years of education allow for something different- an individualized journey that leads students to know who they are and how they will change the world. Centered on one learner at a time, we strive for a just world through understanding, advocacy and service.

The Hoboken Charter School is a public school and all children who live in Hoboken and in neighboring New Jersey districts are encouraged to apply. A random lottery determining enrollment will occur on **Thursday**, **January 16**, **2020** at 3:30 p.m. at the Hoboken Charter School K-8 building located at 713 Washington Street, Hoboken, New Jersey. Priority for enrollment is determined by the following ranking:

- Siblings of currently enrolled students (Hoboken residents)
- Siblings of currently enrolled students (Out-of-District residents)
- 3. Hoboken residents
- 4. Out-of-District residents

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- Complete the enclosed application and return it by mail or hand delivery to 713 Washington Street or via email at lottery@hobokencs.net no later than 5:00pm **Thursday**, **January 9**, **2020**.
- K-8 applicants who would like to have their application weighted must show proof or verification of at least one of the following no later than January 9, 2020 by 5:00 pm: child lives in public housing, child lives in Section 8 housing, child or legal guardian receives SNAP/TANF benefits.

Please note the following:

- Applications received after the deadline date will be considered reserve pool applications.
- Applicants will receive a postcard confirming receipt of their application if received by the lottery deadline date.
- Reserve pool applicants will not receive a confirmation post card.

ENROLLING WITH YOUR LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICT (only when your child has been accepted into the Hoboken Charter School)

Parents/Guardians must register their child with their local school district in order to enroll in a charter school. This applies when:

- a child is entering kindergarten (except if your child is attending a pre-k program that requires registration with your district such as the Abbott Preschool program),
- ❖ a child attended a private school prior to transferring to the Hoboken Charter School,
- families have recently moved to a new address within New Jersey, or
- families have just moved to New Jersey.

Students who are currently attending a public school in New Jersey must obtain a transfer card from their school's main office. Registration is not necessary if attending a public school.

Out-of-District applicants should consult their local Board of Education to determine the appropriate process for registering with your district.
